ROOM NAME	AGE GROUP
Play Studio 1	Babies and young toddler aged children, aged 6 weeks to 2 years
Play Studio 2	Toddler aged children, from 2 to 3 years
Play Studio 3/4	Preschool aged children, from 3 to 5 years. These studios incorporate a preschool aged program for children who will transition to school the following year.

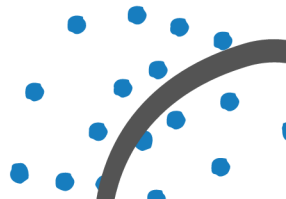
